

Waste Bin Placement Alley Pickup

Please take a few minutes to familiarize yourself with the correct way to use your new bins.

To ensure that you get your bin picked up, refer to the illustrations to the right for the correct placement of your bin on your Collection Day. Occasionally, we may not be able to provide service due to various reasons, such as improper placement of the bin, or bins placed out after the truck has passed by. To avoid having your bin missed, please place your bin out correctly per these illustrations, and have your bin out by 8 am on your Collection Day.

All collection operations are now being video taped.

Always place your bin on the edge of the alley, with the wheels of the bin away from the roadway, as illustrated in Figure 1, with at least four (4) feet of unobstructed space on each side of the bin, and two (2) feet of unobstructed space behind the bin. See Figure 2 for placement in front of a garage or other building. Make sure there are no obstacles that prevent the truck from accessing your bin, or that may be accidentally damaged during collection, such as overhead power lines. Bins must not be placed up against fences or other obstacles, the obstacles will be damaged when the truck's arm reaches, grabs, and lifts the bin.

Thank you for your cooperation with this new waste collection system.

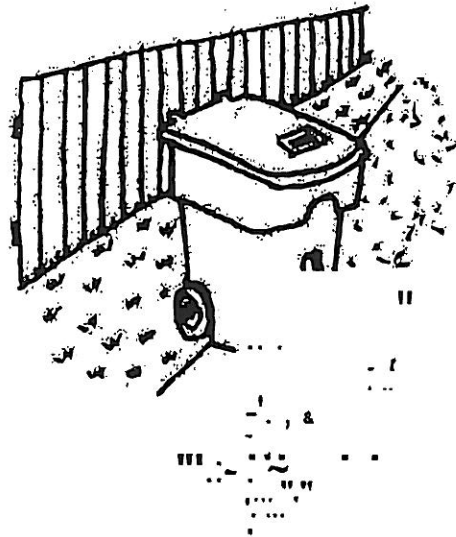
