Income Tax Program

Seniors, low income individuals, or people living on social assistance can get their taxes done free through the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program. The program is supported by Gibbons FCSS and volunteers.

Community members needing the taxes done can drop off their information to the Town Office and volunteers will complete and file their returns for them.

The program begins the beginning of March and runs until the end of April.

Seniors Almost Christmas Dinner

For over 20 years the Town of Gibbons and FCSS have hosted a Seniors Almost Christmas Dinner for local residents 55+. This turkey dinner takes place the 2nd last weekend in November each year at Landing Trail School. Following the dinner entertainment is provided by Gibbons Fire Department and Town Staff.

For a minimal charge, seniors can enjoy what has become an annual tradition. Tickets go on sale mid-October and are available through the Town office.

Meals on Wheels

Meals on Wheels volunteers deliver nutritious meals, including special diets, to Gibbons residents. Anyone who finds meal preparation difficult and would benefit from this service can call 780-578-2109 to initiate the service.

Meals are delivered Monday through Friday, at a cost of \$6.00 per meal. Meals on Wheels is made possible through a partnership with the Spruceview Manor and community support of many organizations, community groups and individuals who contribute volunteer driving and delivery.
