4th Annual Gibbons Neighbour Day Grant 2023

The Town of Gibbons would like to invite you and your community members to apply for the **4th Annual** Gibbons Neighbour Day Grant. Neighbour Day will be held on Saturday June 17th. Please note the maximum amount of funding that a community member or group may request is up to \$250 to help with event related costs.

The Gibbons Neighbour Day Grant will work in the following way...

- Community groups and members can apply for a grant up to \$250 to assist with event related costs in a way they see fit
 PLEASE NOTE: Cheques will come by mail and may not mailed out and received by June 17th, if your application was approved, please do not worry as you will receive a cheque, but it may not be by June 17th
- Neighbour Day events are asked to be held on Neighbour Day June 17th
- Applications are available online @ gibbons.ca and are due by June 6th
- Approved applications will be notified by June 7th
- A follow up report of how the money was used will be due by July 4th

All applications must be received by email no later than Tuesday June 6th Submit applications to epaterson@gibbons.ca
