The Town of Gibbons would like to invite you and your community members to apply for a Block Party Grant during Gibbons Community Week 2023. Please note the maximum amount of funding that a community member or group may request is **up to** \$250 to help with event related costs.

The Gibbons Block Party Grant will work in the following way...

- Community groups and members can apply for a grant **up to** \$250 to assist with event-related costs in a way they see fit.
- Block Parties are asked to be held during Community Week Sept 8-17
- Applications are available online and are due by August 31
- Approved applications will be notified by Sept 1
- A follow up report of how the money was used will be due 30 days after your event

All applications must be received by email no later than Thursday August 31st
