
"Gibbons Badlands Prairie" - A Special Place that Needs Friends!

Did you know that Gibbons has its own version of badlands, such as you see in the Red Deer River valley around Drumheller? A 17.5 hectare stretch of the Sturgeon River escarpment opposite the town of Gibbons has the same steep cliffs of white clay and "popcorn" features that you see in Dinosaur Provincial Park, complete with prickly pear cactus and many of the other species that are more common in southern Alberta prairies. It also has gentler grassland slopes and wooded ravines which together are home for over 160 species of flowering plants including 26 native grasses. The fossil cones of 70 million-year-old cones of coniferous trees have been found there, but unfortunately no dinosaurs.

All this makes what we call "Gibbons Badlands Prairie" a rare and special place, but also one that is sensitive to disturbance. Botanists would like to see a local stewardship group formed, a "Friends of Gibbons Badlands Prairie," perhaps, to help protect it. This group could monitor the site and inform the Town of Gibbons on management issues, as well as engage in outreach to the public and education to promote better appreciation of the Prairie.
